



RESUMPTION GUIDELINES FOR SECOND TERM OF 2021/2022 ACADEMIC SESSION

Dear Esteemed Parents/Guardians,

Just as we prepare for resumption, the College Management wishes all our parents and guardians a year filled with new hope, aspirations and happiness. In our usual practice, the following resumption guidelines have been carefully put together for the attention of all.

A. Schedule of Resumption

- I. The resumption date for all boarding students is **Sunday, 9th January, 2022** while the day students are expected to resume on **Monday, 10th January, 2022**.
- II. Considering the prevailing situation with respect to the gathering of persons, boarding students have been scheduled to resume in batches.
- III. While the students in the Junior Category (JS 1-3) are expected to check into the hostels between **11:00am and 2:00pm**, students in the Senior Category (SS1-2) are all expected to check in between **2:00pm and 5:00pm**.

It is important that all students adhere strictly to their respective schedule of resumption as Management will not accommodate any resumption outside of the stated itinerary.

B. Security Clearance/Exeat Card

- I. As a matter of policy, particularly with respect to the safety of all students, parents will be required to present their **security clearance/exeat cards** to the designated personnel of the college before gaining entry into the college premises during visiting or resumption days.

- II. New parents who are yet to obtain their security clearance card from the school are enjoined to do so by forwarding a well labelled passport (scanned or hard copy) photograph of theirs (having the parents' name(s), the name & class of the child) and/or a well labelled passport photograph of any proxy parent/guardian to exams&record@taidobcollege.org before the resumption date.

C. COVID-19 Protocol

- I. The use of nose mask is compulsory as anyone (students & parents) without it will not be granted entry into the college premises.
- II. It is equally important that everyone follows the directive of the College COVID-19 Task Force for a hitch free resumption.

D. Financial Clearance

- I. It is important to note that access to the hostels/classes on the resumption day will strictly be based on the presentation of **financial clearance** as students who fail to provide same will be turned back.
- II. Parents are hereby enjoined to effect all payments for the term **in favour of TAIDOB COLLEGE**, using the bank details on the teller attached to the bill of their wards on or before the resumption date.
- III. Financial clearance can be printed from the college website taidob.ruffwal.com/parent after the confirmation of fee payment.
- IV. However, parents who experience difficulty in the printing of financial clearance can have same generated for them at the point of entry upon their presentation of payment evidence.

E. Submission of Regular & Special Holiday Assignments

- I. As conveyed in our newsletter, every student is expected to have downloaded and solved (in their school notebooks) the regular assignments given in their core subjects.
- II. In addition, students who scored below forty (40 marks) in any of the subjects offered in the recently concluded **First Term Examination must** download and solve in new (40 or 60 leaves) exercise books, the questions uploaded in those different subjects. Submission of the special assignment remains a precondition for entry into hostels/classes on the resumption day.

F. Hostel Matters

- I. Boarding students are to keep strictly to the room allocated to them by college authority as anyone who contravenes this instruction will be dealt with.
- II. No personal belonging of students will be allowed into the hostels unless they are properly marked/labelled in the student's name (wool-like material to be embroidered while plastic and other non-wool-like material are to be engraved).
- III. Parents/Guardians are to carefully study the College's list of prohibited items and ensure that their wards adhere strictly to the rule as any prohibited item found will be permanently confiscated before such student is severely dealt with.
- IV. It is important that boarding students are provided with at least seven units of 60 leaves exercise books to be used as jotters while observing their study time.
- V. Parents are to note that the use of the college customized bedspread will be enforced as students return to the hostels.

G. Non-statutory visit and dropping of items for students at the College Gate

- I. As conveyed in our previous bulletins, parents are enjoined to get for their wards items that will be sufficient until the **Visiting Day** when such provisions can be replenished.
- II. Only essential materials (e.g. textbooks, notebooks and water) will henceforth be entertained from parents at the College security post and such item must get to the point not later than 5:00pm.
- III. It is important to note that boarding students can only be visited on the days set aside in the **academic calendar** for that purpose. Parents/guardians are to note that no visitation of any sort outside of the ones on the academic calendar will be entertained.

H. Provision of textbooks and other relevant learning materials

Parents are implored to ensure they make adequate provision for textbooks and workbooks (especially in Mathematics and English) and other materials (e.g. mathematical set, four figure table, calculator, dictionary, etc.) which are meant to aid learning as no form of lending or borrowing will be entertained. Parents who still wish to get some of the recommended textbooks/workbooks and other items listed in the hostel requirements can have such purchased in school on the resumption date.

I. Broad Concept Int'l & Entrepreneurship Hub

- I. All newly admitted students are expected to have filled and turned in their entrepreneurship interest forms before the resumption date for appropriate placement.
- II. Students in Robotics and Artificial Intelligence are to note that the **₦15,000** termly training fee is a precondition for access to the unit.

Students must be armed with their training wear and notepad to access the entrepreneurship hub.

- III. Training kits are important as they afford the student quality practice time.
- IV. In addition, students in Catering & Confectioneries are expected to pay the sum of Four Thousand Naira (₦ 4,000) as their termly practical fee.
