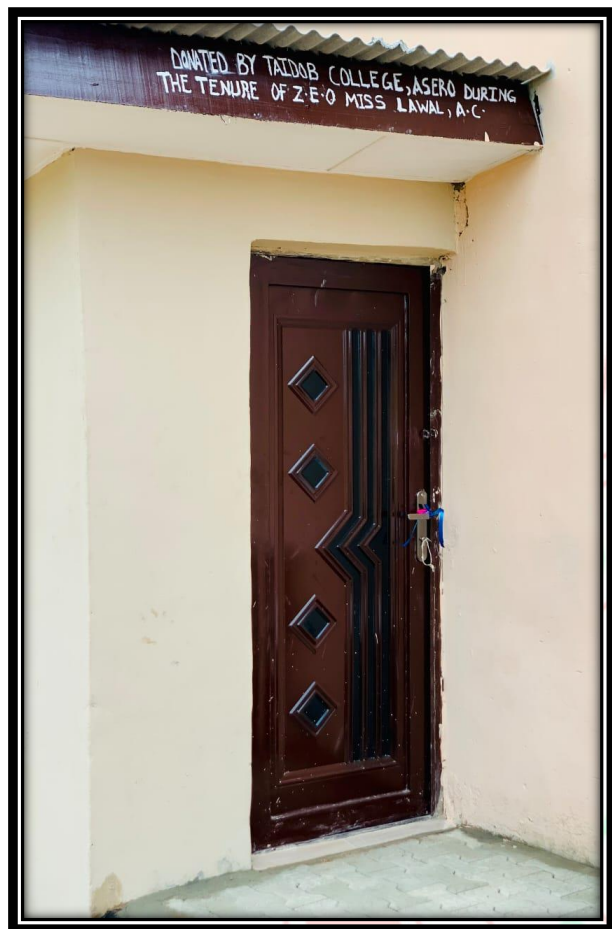

All parents/guardians should kindly note that in view of the prevailing economic situation of the country, the College Management is constrained to review slightly the school fees of the students effective from January, 2023.

PAYMENT OF FEES

All parents/guardians should kindly note that payment can be made through the Point of Sales (POS) machines at the account office of the college for parents who wishes to come to the college premises with their credit cards and do necessary payments through the machine. For the benefit of parents/guardians who cannot come physically to the college premises can explore the usage of Internet Bank Transfer into the school accounts.

Meanwhile, Parents/Guardians are enjoined to pay the School fees of their ward(s) on or before the resumption dates for second term (**Sunday 8th January and Monday 9th January, 2023 for boarders and day students respectively**). Kindly check the school fees breakdown in the school bill as attached and pay accordingly to the designated bank. Evidence of payment should be forwarded to the account department via WhatsApp on **09034016867** for confirmation and financial clearance. Please note: Financial clearance issuance is premised on confirmation of full payment.

IMPORTANT NOTIFICATIONS

1. RESULTS CHECKING

All parents/guardians are to note that ward(s) result can be accessed via the College website. Kindly follow the procedure:

2. SCHOOL UNIFORM

Parents/guardians are to ensure the replacement of worn out uniforms of their wards as some students have been observed to be using either torn and un-customized school cardigan, sportswear, trouser/skirt and stockings. At TAIDOB, appearance matters a lot, it commands respect and dignity. Parents/guardians are therefore advised to make their wards wear only the approved and appropriate uniform. Non-compliance by any student will be frowned at by the school authority during the upcoming term.

3. DEPOSIT OF ITEMS AT THE SECURITY CHECK POINT BY PARENTS

Parents/guardians are to note that only essential items (e.g. table/sachet water and education materials such as textbooks, calculator etc) will be accepted by the college's security men at the security check point and must be within 9:00am and 5:00pm with such items being properly tagged in the child's name for easy identification. Please note that cooked foods, provisions and edible items would not be accepted from parents by the college's security men for use of boarding students on an intermittent basis. We therefore enjoin parents/guardians to provide these items in reasonable and sufficient quantities either at the beginning of the term, during visiting days or during the half term break.

4. SECURITY CLEARANCE CARD

Except God watches over a city, the watcher watches in vain, day by day, the security condition of Nigeria poses a serious concern to the inhabitants, Parents/guardians are therefore advised to give proper orientation, enlightenment, sensitization and guidance to their wards on the need to be security conscious. The college management has put several measures in place to ensure the safety of lives, part of which is the compulsory use of the security exeat card for all parents/guardians (Boarding/Day) intending to visit the college at the point of collecting/returning their ward(s) either during visiting days, resumption days or any other statutory event that require their presence in the college. We therefore enjoin all parents to comply with all security guideline issued by the college's security committee.

5. ARBITRARY REQUEST FOR PERMISSION BY PARENTS AFTER EXAMINATION

We wish to inform our Parents that the College Management will no longer accept arbitrary request for Permission by parents to release their wards after School Examinations. This is because students will still be engaged with series of Academic activities even after their Examinations. We therefore implore our parents to please cooperate with the School Management in this regard.

6. BROAD CONCEPT INTERNATIONAL AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP HUB

The college is still committed to producing entrepreneurs of international standard who will constantly add value to the community wherever they find themselves.

Parents/guardians are to take note that:

- All TAIDOB students must be part of the entrepreneurship programme at the BROAD CONCEPT
- All new students are to pick up an interest form to show their desired skill acquisition/entrepreneurship unit.
- All students must write the entrepreneurship exams and have the result reflect on their General Report Card

However, for a hitch free training programme in the next academic term, parents and guardians are to take note of the following facts:

TOOL KIT

The relevance of having a tool kit to the effective realization of the goal of training cannot be overemphasized. It has been observed that a few students are yet to procure their training kits and this has affected the rate at which they learn as practice they say makes perfection. It is only when a trainee has personal material with which he/she could practice whatever he/she has been taught that learning becomes permanent. We therefore implore all parents to procure the required kits for their wards.

TERMLY TRAINING FEE IN ROBOTICS AND ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

Students undergoing training in Robotics and Artificial Intelligence are by policy of the institute expected to pay a subsidized termly training fee of N 15,000. This is owing to humongous amount required for setting up and getting professional trainers in the field. It is our interest that any student who subscribes to this programme does not miss out at any point on the account of default to meet the financial commitment. To this end, parents are implored to make payment for their wards' training fee in earnest as only those with evidence of payment will be allowed into the unit.

Mode of Payment

For the ease and comfort of all, payments for either the training wear, notepad or personal practice tool kit and termly fees (Robotics & Catering) of students will no longer be accepted in isolation. To this end, all outstanding and or breakdown of fresh payments for all categories of students which henceforth will be attached to the school's bill are expected to be paid directly into the school's account.

8. ILLICIT ACTS ON SOCIAL MEDIA

It has been observed that students are engaging in illicit affairs via the social media platforms on the mobile phones made available to them by their parents. In order to curb this, the Management is advising parents to withdraw access to all forms of communication gadgets at home. Any student found on any of the social media e.g. Instagram, Tik-Tok, Messenger, Facebook, twitter, WhatsApp etc. will be seriously dealt with. Parents are advised to ensure strict compliance in respect to this.

9. BED SPREAD

The usage of customized bedspread is compulsory for all boarding students. The College has made provision for this and parents are enjoined to purchase for their children, as no students will be allowed to use non-customized bedspreads henceforth.

10. WITHDRAWAL OF WARD FROM THE COLLEGE

In as much as we cannot dictate to any parent on his/her choice to withdraw his/her ward from the College, we strongly frown at arbitrary withdrawal of students from the College as it adversely affects our plans and programs against a new term or session.

In view of this, parents/guardians wishing to withdraw their children/wards from the College must forward a term's notice (three months) in writing to the Management. A penal fee of N15, 000.00 per student is to be paid in lieu of notice in the event of default. Parent/guardians whose wards are in their terminal classes (JS3 and SS3) should note that this information also applies to them.

11. CHANGE OF WARDS FROM DAY TO BOARDING AND VICE-VERSA

This is to remind all Parents/Guardians that students who are registered as day or boarding students are not allowed to change their status until the end of the session. This is to allow for effective planning and implementation.

However, any Parent/guardian, who in the course of the session, has to change his/her ward(s) status especially from Boarding to Day Students will still have to continue to pay his/her ward's School fees as boarding till the end of the session. Please be informed.

12. BARBING IN THE HOSTEL

Consequently, the College Management has approved for every parent to come with clipper on visiting days for his or her child/children to have their haircut.

Note: All students should barb a uniformly low cut hairstyle as other form of hairstyles will not be allowed by the College Management.
